



**Thammasat University Notification on
Undergraduate Admissions in
Bachelor of Arts (Chinese Studies Program) and Bachelor of Arts (Thai Studies Program)
Pridi Banomyong International College (PBIC)
Academic Year 2022**

Thammasat University is open for accepting its Undergraduate Admissions Applications for Bachelor of Arts, Chinese Studies Program and Thai Studies Program (International Programs) at Pridi Banomyong International College for the Academic Year 2022. Pridi Banomyong International College (PBIC), Thammasat University (Tha Prachan) hereby announces the details of eligibility requirements and application procedures as follows:

1. Location

1.1. Pridi Banomyong International College, Thammasat University (Tha Prachan)

2. Eligibility Requirements

2.1. General Requirements

2.1.1. Applicants must have finished at least high school (Upper secondary education level) or hold a high school equivalency credential, both domestically and internationally, with the following conditions: Not being a student of a university or other higher education institution unless studying in an open university or distance learning (online) courses that have earned a degree.

Remark: Applicants, who have not or have finished their upper secondary education level from an educational institution/a high school abroad or international schools in Thailand, must submit academic transcripts to Pridi Banomyong International College for consideration according to the Thammasat University's Announcement on Thammasat University's Guidelines on Equivalency of High School Qualifications, issued in 2021.

And The Council of University Presidents of Thailand's Criteria on Equivalency of High School Qualifications in University Admission 2022, announced on February 25, 2021. 2.1.2. Applicants must not be a student of a university or other higher education institution unless studying in an open university or distance learning courses with undergraduate certifications.

2.1.3. Applicants must not be a patient or in a condition that would be a serious obstacle to the study

2.1.4. Applicants must not be a person who acted morally wrong or with excessive bad behavior history.

2.2. Specific Requirements

2.2.1. Applicants must have at least one of the English Language Proficiency test certifications as listed below with the test results taken within 2 years prior to the application date. (Except for international student whose English is a native language):

(1) IELTS (Academic) 6.0 OR

(2) TOEFL (IBT) 61 OR TOEFL (ITP, PBT) 500 OR

(3) TU-GET (PBT) 500 OR TU-GET (CBT) 61 OR

(4) New SAT system (Reading and Writing) 400 OR

(5) GSAT (Reading, Writing, and Language) 400 OR

(6) English Language Proficiency test held by Pridi Banomyong International College on Sunday, April 10th, 2022, from 9:00 A.M. - 12:00 P.M.

2.2.2. Applicants who apply within the Inter program – Admission 1 and have the English language proficiency test scores that do not meet with the criteria as in the section 2.2.1., but have English proficiency test scores not lower than the following criteria.

(1) IELTS (Academic) 4.5

(2) TOEFL (IBT) 32 OR TOEFL (ITP, PBT) 400

(3) TU-GET (PBT) 400 points or TU-GET (CBT) 32 points

If qualified, applicants will be required to participate in the Pre-session English course and complete its course evaluation and assessment before the beginning of the semester. Otherwise, the applicants will be considered ineligible and unqualified for the admissions to Pridi Banomyong International College.

2.2.3. For Chinese Studies Program Applications

(1) If applicants with HSK Level 4 (180 points) with the test results less than 2 years prior to the date of application have been qualified, **the applicants will be required to study at the college in the study plan specifically provided for those who have passed HSK Level 4 (180 points).**

(2) If applicants without HSK Level 4 scores (180 points) have been qualified, **there will be a Chinese language proficiency test held for the applicants by the college.**

- **Applicants with the scores equivalent or more than 65%,** will be required to study according to the study plan as mentioned in the section 2.2.3 (1).

- **Applicants with the scores less than 65%,** will be required to participate in the Pre-session Chinese course before the Start of the Academic Semester 1/2022 as follows:

- (a) **Applicants who have test score between 0 – 40%,** are required to participate in **the Pre-session Chinese program level 1 and 2.**

- (b) **Applicants who have test score between 41% - 64%,** are required to participate in **the Pre-session Chinese program level 2**

3. Number of Admitted Applicants

The total number of applicants admitted for the PBIC admissions 2022 are as follows:

Remark:

1. In the case that the number of admissions in Inter Portfolio 1, Inter Portfolio 2 and Inter Program - Admission 1 are not achieved, the number will be added in the next round until the target number is reached.
2. Pridi Banomyong International College has also open to accept admission applications in the TCAS 3 Admission Round through the admission system of the Council of University Presidents of Thailand (CUPT). For more information, please visit student.mycas.com.

4. Application terms and conditions

4.1 If applicants are successfully qualified to study at Pridi Banomyong International College, the applicants can decide to study in only one particular field of study – either Chinese Studies Program or Thai Studies Program only. Nonetheless, the applicants can apply for many fields of study or apply for any admission rounds according to the specified criteria, but once confirmed the right to enroll through TCAS64, applicants will not be able to apply in the next admission round.

To be eligible to apply for the next admission round, applicants must waive any pre-existing rights to enroll through the Thai university Central Admission System or TCAS64 within the specified period only. Please note that a waiver of the pre-existing rights can only be done once before being eligible to apply for a new admission round. Waiving the right to enroll outside of the specified period does not count as waiving the right in the TCAS64 system. For more information, please visit <https://student.mycas.com/>.

- 4.2 Applicants must verify and certify themselves that they meet all admission requirements according to this announcement. If the university discovers later that the applicant does not meet the specified criteria, the applicant will be considered disqualified. In the event that the application fee has been paid, the application fee will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- 4.3 Before applying for any admission rounds, applicants must read through the details of program of study they wish to apply for which has been published on the website of Pridi Banomyong International College at www.pbic.tu.ac.th.

5. Selection Procedures/Criteria.

5.1. Inter Portfolio 1 and Inter Portfolio 2

- 5.1.1. Portfolio must be uploaded in the application system process and presented on the day of the interview.
- 5.1.2. English language proficiency test scores as stated in the section 2.2.1 (Foreign students whose native language is English, are not required to submit English language test results).
- 5.1.3. Interview score.

5.2. Inter Program – Admission 1

- 5.2.1. English language proficiency test scores as stated in the sections 2.2.1 and 2.2.2 (Foreign students whose native language is English, are not required to submit English language test results).
- 5.2.2. Written test score (English Essay Writing Test about Chinese studies and Thai studies).
- 5.2.3. Interview score.

5.3. Inter Program – Admission 2

- 5.3.1. English language proficiency test scores as stated in the item 2.2.1 (Foreign students whose native language is English, are not required to submit English language test results).
- 5.3.2. Interview score.

5.4. Others terms and conditions

- 5.4.1. Eligible candidates must carry out the procedures as stipulated in this announcement and show up to take the exam on the specified date, time and location, otherwise it will be considered a waiver.
- 5.4.2. In the selection process of eligible applicants, it will be considered from applicants who have a total score in order according to the specified score criteria according to the number of students admitted.
- 5.4.3. The English and Chinese language test scores used in the application must be taken within 2 years prior to the application date.
- 5.4.4. Applicants studying at an international school in Thailand, who have not completed their high school, and are studying in Grade 12 or equivalent, and expect to finish their high school (Grade 12) by July 2022, must submit academic results including the results of 4 semesters of upper secondary education level, as proof of applications. *Applicants must submit proof of applications showing that they will complete their high school to the college by August 1, 2022, otherwise the applicants will be considered disqualified.*
- 5.4.5. The resolution and consideration of the admission committee is considered absolutely final.
- 5.4.6. The applicants cannot request for the refunds of the application fee under any circumstances.

6. Application Procedures

6.1. Apply by submit required documents through the online admission system via the website www.pbic.tu.ac.th

6.2. Application Fee: 1,000 baht.

6.3. Application Fee Payment

The Payment of the application fee of 1,000 baht can be made through the Bill Payment system (4 channels: Bank counters, Internet Banking, Mobile Banking, and ATMs). Applicants will receive Pay-in Slip for payment. Please use the pay-in slip through the Bill Payment system after applying via the online admission system at www.pbic.tu.ac.th

6.4. Applicants must bring the original documents of all the required documents and proof of applications for the admission according to the sections 2.1 and 2.2 to the college on the day of the written and interview examinations.

9. Pre-sessional Courses for Successfully Admitted Applicants

Thammasat University has stated in its policies to have those successfully selected to study in the university to take the "GREATS" English language proficiency and competency tests in order to assess their competency level and survival skills for the 21st century of students, including creating a system to promote and build students' competencies according to the "GREATS" approach to enable students to develop and bring out the best in themselves based on their individual potential, and become successful leaders for the new generation in the 21st century.

10. Enrollment Conditions (For those who are eligible to register as a PBIC student.)

To be eligible to enroll for the registration as Thammasat University students, enrollees must meet the following requirements:

- 10.1. Enrollees must be selected and eligible to study at Thammasat University according to this course
- 10.2. Enrollees must have completed their high school (Grade 12) or its equivalent level. If it appears that the eligible enrollee does not meet the required educational level, The eligible enrollee will be considered disqualified to study by Thammasat University.

If Thammasat University finds out later that any eligible enrollees have not met any specified requirements, this eligibility will be deemed void and any fee payment occurred will not be refunded under any circumstances.

10.3. The Enrollment Process for Freshmen is based on the Regulations and Announcements of Thammasat University for Undergraduate Degree Programs, issued in 2018.

11. Tuition Fees and Other Fees

Students must make a payment of tuition fees and other related fees throughout the whole duration of their undergraduate program as stated in the regulations and announcements listed below:
